### Expressing agreement

- **(weak)** I suppose so./I guess so.
- I agree with you 100 percent.
- I couldn't agree more.
- That's so true.
- That's for sure.
- Absolutely
- You're absolutely right.
- Exactly.
- I'm afraid I agree with James.
- I have to side with Matthew on this one.
- No doubt about it.
- I was just going to say that.
- **(agree with negative statement)** er.

- (agree with positive statement) So I am / So have you according to the verb used by your interlocutor
- (slang) Tell me about it!

Expressing disagreement

- 
- *I don't think so.*
- *I'm afraid I disagree.*
- *Not necessarily.*
- *That's not always true.*
- *That's not always the case.*
- *No, I'm not so sure about that.*
- (strong) *No way.*
- (strong) *I totally disagree.*
- (strong) *I'd say the exact opposite.*

Interruptions

- Can I add something here?
- Is it okay if I jump in for a second?
- If I might add something...
- Can I throw my two cents in?
- Sorry to interrupt, but...
- (after accidentally interrupting someone) OR Sorry, you were saying...
- (after being interrupted) You didn't let me finish.

Settling an argument

- *Let's drop it.*
- *I think we're going to have to agree to disagree.*
